

The Youth and Honors Orchestras of Monterey County provide powerful and fun learning experiences under the direction of professional conductor John Larry Granger. Not only is Mr. Granger entertaining, he is dynamic, interesting, and he communicates well with students. His educational style helps young musicians improve and achieve very high standards.

Membership is open by audition to students in Monterey County (and beyond)—from Salinas to Monterey, from Big Sur to Santa Cruz. The orchestras perform three concerts during the school year; two performances are held at the Sunset Center in Carmel and the finale concert at Sherwood Hall in Salinas.

This is a great opportunity for serious musicians to receive the high-caliber training they need for success in school music, college and other adult pursuits. The groups study a variety of classical music, including modern composers. Instrumentation includes strings, woodwinds, brass, and percussion. Nothing will improve your playing more than learning classical repertoire!

The Youth Orchestra has students from age 7 and older, and rehearses from 4:30 to 6:00 pm on Wednesdays, throughout the school year at Monterey High School. The Honors Orchestra plays full symphonic scores and is open to students up to the age of 20 and rehearses from 6:45 to 8:30 pm, also at Monterey High.

We are accepting jazz instrumentalists to join our Honors Orchestras of Youth Music Monterey for our Spring concert on Sunday, May 2, 2010. Specifically, we are looking for talented musicians playing saxophone, brass and percussion instruments. The orchestra will be performing Gershwin's symphonic orchestra piece "An American in Paris" which includes these instruments. To apply, simply fill out an application online at www.youthmusicmonterey.org and click on "registration materials" to request an audition appointment or call (831) 375-1992 for further information. Auditions will be held on the first rehearsal on Wednesday, March 3, 2010 at the Monterey High School Band Room located at 700 Pacific Street in Monterey from 6:15 pm-6:45 pm. The cost is a \$50 deposit to secure an audition and \$100 tuition towards participating in the rehearsals and concert.

Welcome to the second concert of our 2009 - 10 Season!

Today's program, entitled "Making Overtures," features exciting selections, each an opening showstopper in its own right.

We are pleased to welcome the members of **Orchestra in the Schools** as they perform with our **Youth Orchestra** in Beethoven's "Egmont Overture," composed for Goethe's play about triumph over tyranny. The Youth Orchestra continues with Merle Isaac's "Overture Russe," which features a medley of older Russian folk and dance music. Richard Meyer was commissioned to write his overture "Millennium" in 1998. The work, which vividly features the brass and percussion sections, won the National School Orchestra Association Composition Contest. This part of today's concert concludes with Ernesto Lecuona's "Andalucia Suite," a collection of lively dances from Spain.

Our advanced brass ensemble is making their premiere performance today under the direction of the section's coach, Mr. Alex Bedner. Their selections will open the **Honors Orchestra** portion of today's concert.

We are very proud to present this year's Solo Competition Winner, *Perry Choi*, performing the first movement of Mozart's "Clarinet Concerto". The clarinet was invented during Mozart's time, and the instrument quickly became a mainstay in the standard orchestra. The composer brilliantly captures the range and characteristic voice of the instrument in this most important and famous solo work.

By the end of the eighteenth century composers were including melodies in their opera overtures that would be heard later during the dramatic action. By the late 1800's, Johann Strauss was all the rage in Vienna. His "Overture to Die Fledermaus," (The Bat), anticipates many of the melodies the audience is to experience during this amusing tale of romantic sophistication and intrigue.

The music from Saint-Saëns "Bacchanale" from the opera "Samson and Delilah" depicts quite a bit more than just 'making overtures' and is a frequent encore selection for major touring orchestras.

As always, I would like to thank our wonderful private teachers and symphony coaches who perform such excellent work in preparing our students for these programs. We couldn't do it without their support.

Enjoy the concert!

Building the next generation of musicians and music lovers



Our mission is to provide high-caliber opportunities and incentives for young people to enrich their lives and benefit the community through the performance and greater understanding of music.

The Youth and Honors Orchestras: Each year, the Youth and Honors Orchestras provide approximately 100 students an opportunity to supplement their school and private music studies with high-caliber ensemble playing experience under the direction of professional conductor John Larry Granger. This experience helps them develop knowledge of symphonic literature, as well as technical and artistic skill. The orchestras draw many of the best young musicians from throughout Monterey County - from Salinas and Aromas to Carmel Valley and Pebble Beach.

South County Music Program: YMM's South County Music Program involves formal partnerships between YMM and a number of South County school districts, including Monterey County Home Charter School, San Antonio Union School, and Bradley Union School. A team of string instructors provide violin, viola, and cello instruction in private or group lessons either during the school day or immediately following. Students are not charged for the lessons. YMM and the schools share the cost of the instructors' salaries. YMM provides students with instruments for a modest monthly rental cost.

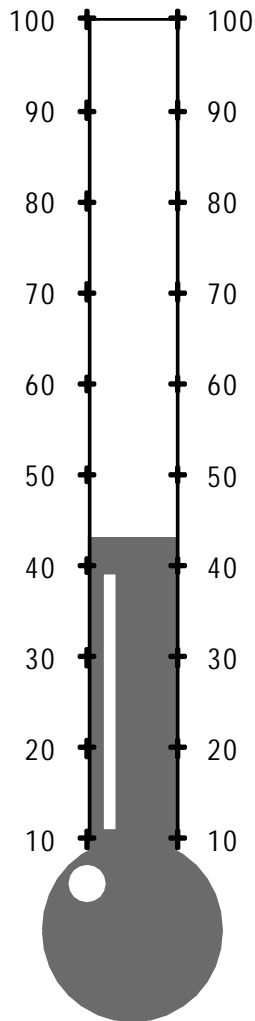

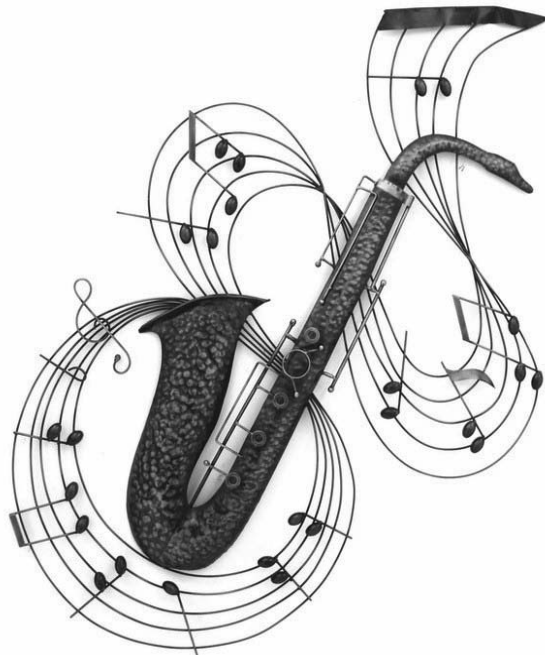

will perform the first movement of Mozart's Clarinet Concerto in A Major. A junior and high honor student at York School, Perry has been a member of Youth Music Monterey for the past four years and currently is the principal clarinetist. He is also the principal clarinetist for the San Jose Youth Symphony Philharmonic.

Perry began playing music at the age of 6 first on the piano followed by the clarinet at age 10. Aside from playing music, he also enjoys composing and listening to music and playing on his school varsity golf team. He excels in his academic subjects, including math, and recently placed 2nd in Calculus at the Monterey County Athletics Competition.

Perry studies clarinet with Erica Horn and has also had lessons with Theresa Hruby-Purcell and Mark Brandenburg. He plans on majoring in music in college, along with another major in Biology, Physics, or Biomedical Engineering.

Perry's proudest musical achievement has been the creation of Keeping Music Alive, a program which allows talented high school musicians to provide, for free, a music program for an elementary school that does not currently have one. Although it's been rough beginnings due to a lack of instruments, those that have gotten instruments are learning quickly, and he is proud to be a part of that child's learning. Perry's next clarinet performance will be at the MidAmerica Productions National Collegiate Wind Ensemble at *Carnegie Hall* near the end of May.

John Larry Granger (Conductor)

is the Music Director of the Youth and Honors Orchestras of Youth Music Monterey and the Santa Cruz County Youth Symphony. Deeply devoted to music education, Mr. Granger brings professional conducting skills and a dynamic teaching style to approximately 130 high-level students ages 7-20 who are involved in the program each year.

Maestro Granger has served for seventeen years as Music Director of the Youth and Honors Orchestras of Youth Music Monterey and the Santa Cruz County Symphony. He has also been a featured guest conductor with the New Haven Symphony, San Jose Symphony, Long Beach Symphony, Fresno Philharmonic, and Springfield Symphony, among others. He is in his sixth year as Music Director/Conductor of the Santa Cruz Ballet Theatre Orchestra, and served for nine years as the Music Director of the South Coast Symphony Orchestra in Costa Mesa. He has also conducted the Pomona College Orchestra from 1989-91.

Mr. Granger attended the International Institute for Orchestral Conducting from 1979-81 and did private study in Dresden in 1981 with Herbert Blomstedt, Music Director of the Leipzig Gewandhaus Orchestra and Conductor Laureate of the San Francisco Symphony. Born in New York, Granger began his career as an oboist and English horn player.


James Paoletti, Music Director - Orchestra in the Schools
