The Youth and Honors Orchestras of Monterey County provide powerful and fun learning experiences under the direction of professional conductor John Larry Granger. Not only is Mr. Granger entertaining, he is dynamic, interesting, and he communicates well with students. His educational style helps young musicians improve and achieve very high standards.

Membership is open by audition to students in Monterey County (and beyond)—from Salinas to Monterey, from Big Sur to Santa Cruz. The orchestras perform three concerts during the school year. Last year, two performances were held at the Sunset Center in Carmel and both were nearly SOLD OUT.

This is a great opportunity for serious musicians to receive the high-caliber training they need for success in school music, college and other adult pursuits. The groups study a variety of classical music, including modern composers. Instrumentation includes strings, woodwinds, brass, and percussion. Nothing will improve your playing more than learning classical repertoire!

The Youth Orchestra has students from age 7 and older, and rehearses from 4:30 to 6:00 pm on Wednesdays, throughout the school year at Monterey High School. The Honors Orchestra plays full symphonic scores and is open to students up to the age of 20 and rehearses from 6:45 to 8:30 pm, also at Monterey High.

There may be limited openings for select instruments in either orchestra for the current 2009-10 season, so please inquire ASAP if you are interested in auditioning.

Welcome to our 2009 - 10 Season!

This year promises to be an exciting year for both the Youth and Honors Orchestra of Youth Music Monterey. We have some very talented and committed young musicians who will be performing some “Thrilling Marches and Dances” for you today.

The Youth Orchestra opens with the dramatic March from Verdi’s opera, “Aida.” The music features our growing brass and percussion sections. The pageantry of the music is enhanced by the richness of the string and woodwind sections. Frédéric Chopin, known for his virtuosic piano music, also composed the ballet, *Les Sylphides*. The ballet has no written story, but visually expresses the Romantic qualities of the composer’s unique style. Far from the delicate dances of Chopin are the rustic Russian folk qualities of Glière’s *Red Poppy*. The “Russian Sailor’s Dance” is a brilliantly orchestrated theme and variations that will bring the first half of the concert to an exciting conclusion.

The Honors Orchestra will present three major symphonic works. Rossini’s *Overture to the Barber of Seville* is a thrilling work built with rhythmic motifs that grow with crescendos of increasing instrumentation. Special solos are given by the oboe, clarinet, French horn, and bassoon. Romanian composer, George Enescu, captured the heart of his country’s folk music in his *First Rhapsody*. Opening with dialogues between solo clarinet and oboe, the music quickly evolves into a rapid-dance that propels the listener to a full dramatic climax of the Romantic sized orchestra. Dances were frequently a part of many operas. The Czech composer, Bedřich Smetana, was a contemporary of Dvorák. Smetana’s “Three Dances” from the opera *the Bartered Bride* are filled with syncopated rhythms, humor, and grand orchestration. The final “Dance of the Comedians” demands great skill and dexterity from the violin section and builds to thrilling conclusion.

Thank you for attending today’s concert and supporting these fine musicians. Enjoy the concert!

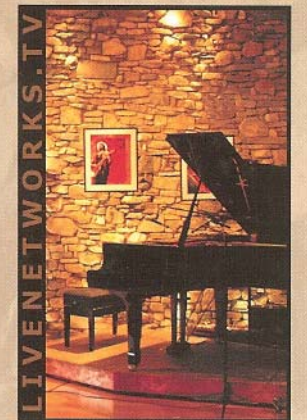

Youth Music Monterey
Building the next generation of musicians and music lovers

Our mission is to provide high-caliber opportunities and incentives for young people to enrich their lives and benefit the community through the performance and greater understanding of music.

The Youth and Honors Orchestras: Each year, the Youth and Honors Orchestras provide approximately 100 students an opportunity to supplement their school and private music studies with high-caliber ensemble playing experience under the direction of professional conductor John Larry Granger. This experience helps them develop knowledge of symphonic literature, as well as technical and artistic skill. The orchestras draw many of the best young musicians from throughout Monterey County - from Salinas and Aromas to Carmel Valley and Pebble Beach.

South County Strings: YMM's South County Strings program involves formal partnerships between YMM and a number of South County school districts, including Monterey County Home Charter School, San Antonio Union School, and Bradley Union School. A team of string instructors provide violin, viola, and cello instruction in private or group lessons either during the school day or immediately following. Students are not charged for the lessons. YMM and the schools share the cost of the instructors' salaries. YMM provides students with instruments for a modest monthly rental cost.

John Larry Granger (Conductor) is the Music Director of the Youth and Honors Orchestras of Youth Music Monterey and the Santa Cruz County Youth Symphony. Deeply devoted to music education, Mr. Granger brings professional conducting skills and a dynamic teaching style to approximately 130 high-level students ages 7-20 who are involved in the program each year.

Maestro Granger has served for seventeen years as Music Director of the Youth and Honors Orchestras of Youth Music Monterey and the Santa Cruz County Symphony. He has also been a featured guest conductor with the New Haven Symphony, San Jose Symphony, Long Beach Symphony, Fresno Philharmonic, and Springfield Symphony, among others. He is in his sixth year as Music Director/Conductor of the Santa Cruz Ballet Theatre Orchestra, and served for nine years as the Music Director of the South Coast Symphony Orchestra in Costa Mesa. He has also conducted the Pomona College Orchestra from 1989-91.

Mr. Granger attended the International Institute for Orchestral Conducting from 1979-81 and did private study in Dresden in 1981 with Herbert Blomstedt, Music Director of the Leipzig Gewandhaus Orchestra and Conductor Laureate of the San Francisco Symphony. Born in New York, Granger began his career as an oboist and English horn player.
